New Business:

- Tardies have been an issue at HHS. Should on-time attendance be considered when purchasing tickets to a school dance? 1100-1200 students attended the Homecoming Dance. We'd like to consider tracking tardies for two weeks before a dance and students who have 5 or more accumulated tardies would not be permitted to attend that dance. Also, consider if Prom could or should be tied to 2nd quarter attendance. Should we start with Sadie Hawkins in November? Or the dance in December?
- Amendment Update -- Amendments must be directly tied to students. The recent amendment has been updated; sections 5-9 have been removed and sections 1-4 retained.
