New Business:

- 3. The Health department curriculum still has not been implemented this semester, because the software and curriculum has to be approved through the district, which will take about a month.
- 4. The final report has again been postponed to March. Roxanne is waiting to receive the data on graduation rates and meeting our goals for last year.
- 5. Some council members expressed concern about overuse of chromebooks at home, and the lack of control or filters. There was also an issue of PG-13 and R-rated movies being shown in class without getting parental permission slips.
