New Business:

Roxanne Ohran:

1. Community Council member phone numbers were removed from the district, state, and school sites because of reports of harassment. Board members felt this was needed and will wait for the law to catch up that currently requires parent board member phone numbers to be on the site.
2. Courtney Carsey is on medical leave from participating in the community council for the rest of the year. Her position will most likely be filled by another faculty member and appointed by Ryan Oaks.

Parent Questions/Comments:

1. Brenda Shamo attended the District Community Council meeting. There was a presentation about digital citizenship. Brenda appreciated that in addition to safely navigating digital media, there was also an emphasis on using the digital resources for good and helping our students.

Granite intends to implement a pilot program called Panorama. Surveys are taken by students 3 times a year to assess early warnings for bullying and other needs of students. Concerns over privacy and parent notification were not addressed as this is a pilot program.
