New Business

Ryan Oaks - Everything went smooth with the first day of implementing the weapons detection systems. Students are getting in the habit of pulling out the chromebook. Lines to get into the building were very limited and there were no seen issues.

Council Member: Esther Olschewski - Expressed concerns that this system is an invasion of student privacy and that students are being gas lit.

Reviewed the final report from 2021-2022. Some alterations will be made for data specific to participation in College Enrollment. Ideas for including parents more in the College and Career Readiness Report.

Reviewed the current school plan for 2023-2024 and reviewed if it needs any changes. The final vote will be in the March community council meeting. Current adjustments discussed is to change Goal #1 to increase the graduation rate by 1%. Weather was getting bad and members of the council were given the School Plan and asked to email possible suggestions to Ryan Oaks and Roxanne Ohran. Further adjustments will then be sent out to council members to review and respond in support of adjustments.

Parent Questions/Comments

Discussion - Credit recovery is continually improving. The district is working on updating paper packets and some schools are using an online program called Edgenuity. How can we help motivate students to improve their attendance, pass classes, and remediate credits sooner. One possible way to help is to include mentors from the community and other grade levels. Another idea is to create a buddy system between

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incoming ninth graders and Seniors in a more social atmosphere. The social aspect could be having a buddy lunch or social event during the year.

Proposals

Technology: Translating earbuds. Library/STS (Woolf \$5,099.83) This was approved with two members who were opposed.

Technology: Chromebooks. Library/STS (Woolf \$13,146.00) This was approved by all.
Curriculum/Educational Resources: LIA conference for students. World Languages (Anderson 600.00) This was approved by all.
