Agenda Items

It was announced that Maralee Vincent will not be able to serve and has resigned. The election runners-up will be contacted and invited to take her place. If those invitations are declined, sitting members of the Council will bring names of possible appointees to the November meeting.

Election of Officers—Marni Allred unanimously elected to serve as Council Chair with Melissa Farnworth elected as Vice-Chair. (Deanna nominated and voted for Karel Nelson as Vice-Chair)

The rules of order that were in effect for 2013-2014 were abided by for this meeting. They will be updated by Marni to reflect changes to the laws and guidelines for Community Councils then presented at the November meeting for approval. The new rules will include a clause governing attendance by Council Members.

CC Training Videos were viewed by all present and the accompanying handouts were distributed.

The SSAP was reviewed by Doug Wagstaff and discussed for any required clarifications. A vote of approval was taken and passed unanimously.

LAND Trust 2013-2014 Final Report was presented by Doug Wagstaff and approved by unanimous vote. Some discussion was held concerning the amount of carryover funds and the Council is aware of what changes need to be made as the Plan is written for the coming year so that we will better utilize the allotted funds.

Some non-binding discussion was held concerning the amount of homework that is assigned to students and Doug agreed to remind teachers that the students have seven classes and all of their teachers require assignments of them. Parents were reminded that they are welcome to bring specific concerns to the Principal at any time. There was also discussion of the responsibility of the school and faculty concerning personal safety of students who are threatening to harm themselves in any way. Parents were encouraged to report concerns about their own children or their children's friends as the school has several District-wide resources available to help troubled youth.

Agenda items for the next meeting should be submitted to Marni or Doug by November 3 so that the agenda can be posted to the school's website.
