Review/Approval of Previous Minutes: Kendra Smith

Officer Mike Millet— Crosswalk on 3500 S. and SNAP Safe Walk Route

Erik Brondum P.E. from West Valley City Public Works came. He discussed the cross guard that would most likely be put in 3500 S. by Deann Dr. for student to cross 3500 S. to get to Hunter Jr. next year. He said this was a UDOT, West Valley City, and Salt Lake County operation since 3500 S. was a state road. It will most like be a crossing guard that the student push a button and it flashes red to stop traffic, it stays red while the cross, and then flashes allowing cars to move forward if there are no children present. There is one on 4700 S. by the 4000 W intersection. They hope to have it ready or something else for the next school year, but there are no promises.

6400 W. was mentioned as a possible problem for crossing due to lighting, lack of sidewalks, and only one crosswalk. Mr. Brondum stated like everything money is an issue although safety is a major concern, money is a bottom line. He was aware of the sidewalk issues on 6400 W. and 6000 W. as well as 4700 S.

The Walking Pool App was discussed as a possibility for students and parents to help with safe route walking. Also, we need to determine and go online to draw our SNAP Safe Walk Route. It will probably be an April project.
