Agenda item 1 – Anti bullying plan:

Reviewed the Anti-bullying plan along with Whitney Garcia from the PBIS committee.

Agenda item 2 – School Report Card:

Reviewed Jackling's Behavior Plan. Which includes:

1. Positive Behavior Expectations – P.A.W.S = Positivity, Accountability, Wise Choices, Safety
2. Bullying Prevention – Defined what is bullying, why is this definition important, and what the most common causes of bullying behavior? Teachers have received training to understand and detect PTSD behaviors. Reviewed the purpose of the safeut website. This is a great resource for example if a parent is concerned about their children's home life, or simply another student's wellbeing.
3. Suicide Prevention – Covers how to train faculty and parents on warning signs and train faculty how to respond to suicide ideation.
4. Substance Abuse Prevention – Geared towards 5th grade. BOTVIN Life Skills Training
5. Interventions – On average 20% of students need more support than given in the previous points. This support is separated into tiers depending on the severity of the situation.
6. Communication – Jackling has several ways this information is communicated to the parents.
7. School Report Card = F – This was not previously available due to Covid but it is posted now and we are currently an F.
