Consequences for their actions

- What can the school do to hold parents accountable?
- How can they make parents come to class? We can't
- Positive consequence

How do we help parents learn and attending continuing education?

- Requiring attendance at meetings
- Do more activities with the kids
- Parents are more reactive than proactive - when can we go immediately when we need it no just this one time a year.
- Can we serve the parents, a sort of police officer will show up and make sure the actual person gets it.
- Your signature doesn't mean you are accepting what happens, but you are acknowledging you have received it.

What could the school do to build better partnerships with parents?

- Parent support groups.
- All the papers that are sent home is majority in English and send home more in Spanish.
- Explain the purpose of home visits MUCH better!
- It was odd that it wasn't the teacher for the class
- It could be nice to do in the Spring with next year's teacher or in the fall. It was WEIRD that it was happening in the middle of the year.
- Everyone can benefit from therapy. Can we partner with any organizations to offer a one-time visit and have parents participate as well?
