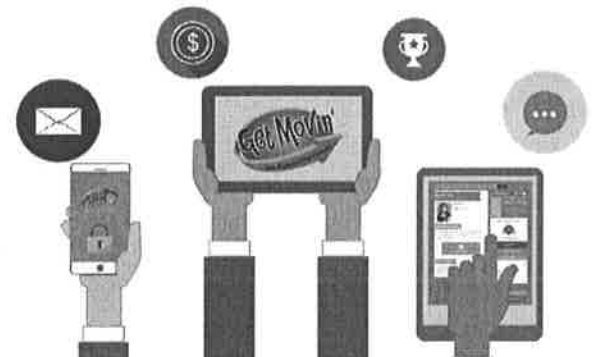

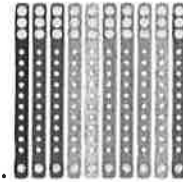

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Granite School District provides school choice enrollment in all schools where space is available. Parents are responsible for transportation when exercising school choice. This letter explains Granite School District's Open Enrollment Guidelines; Open Enrollment is necessary for students to attend a school other than their home boundary school.

There are two open enrollment periods: Early Open Enrollment and Late Open Enrollment. The Early Open Enrollment period is the recommended time to enroll for the next school year as it is based on the school building capacity. The Early Open Enrollment period for the 2024-2025 school year begins on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 and ends on Friday, February 2, 2024. The Late Open Enrollment period is anytime outside of the early window and is based on the school's adjusted capacity and may be applied for at any time. Open Enrollment Applications are submitted electronically and can be found on Granite District's and each school's website and are processed in the order received. Students residing within Granite School District boundaries are given priority. Enrollment depends on space available in the requested grade, class, or program. Open Enrollment requests do not require a release from the student's home school or district.

If your student is accepted for Open Enrollment, annual reapplication is not required —as long as the student remains in the same school, and space is available. When a student transitions from elementary school to junior high, or from junior high to high school, there is no automatic feeder system for Open Enrollment; therefore, reapplication is necessary to attend a school outside of the student's home boundary school.

El Distrito Escolar de Granite ofrece inscripción de elección de escuela en todas las escuelas donde hay espacio disponible. Los padres son responsables del transporte cuando ejercen la elección de escuela. Esta carta explica [las Guías de Inscripción Abierta del Distrito Escolar de Granite](#); La Inscripción Abierta es necesaria para que los estudiantes asistan a una escuela que no sea su escuela de límite de origen.

Hay dos períodos de Inscripción Abierta: **Inscripción Abierta Temprana** e **Inscripción Abierta Tardía**. El período de **Inscripción Abierta Temprana** es el momento recomendado para inscribirse para el próximo año, ya que se basa en la capacidad de construcción de la escuela. El período de **Inscripción Abierta Temprana** para el año escolar 2024-2025 comienza el miércoles 15 de noviembre de 2023 y finaliza el viernes 2 de febrero de 2024. El período de **Inscripción Abierta Tardía** es en cualquier momento fuera de la ventana temprana y se basa en la capacidad ajustada de la escuela y se puede solicitar en cualquier momento. Las solicitudes de Inscripción Abierta se envían electrónicamente y se pueden encontrar en el sitio web del Distrito Escolar de Granite y en el sitio web de cada escuela individual. Todas las solicitudes de Inscripción Abierta se procesan en el orden en que se reciben. Los estudiantes que residen dentro de los límites del Distrito Escolar de Granite tienen prioridad. La inscripción depende del espacio disponible en el grado, clase o programa solicitado. Las solicitudes de Inscripción Abierta no requieren la aprobación de la escuela o distrito de origen del estudiante.

Si su estudiante es aceptado para la Inscripción Abierta, no se requiere una nueva solicitud anual, si el estudiante permanece en la misma escuela y si hay espacio disponible. Cuando un estudiante hace la transición de la escuela primaria a la secundaria, o de la escuela secundaria a la escuela preparatoria, es necesario volver a solicitar para asistir la nueva escuela, si no sea la escuela límite del hogar del estudiante.
