GRADE POINT AVERAGE

A student must maintain a weighted GPA of 3.800 or above for the first, second and third term of the year before application is made. The student must meet the same requirement during the fourth term until the letters are awarded. (No exceptions) *Point System—Add .1 to the term grade point average for each Honors and AP Class (Includes Concurrent Enrollment).

CITIZENSHIP

No 0's and no 1's may be accumulated during the first three terms. NO CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS IT IS DETERMINED THAT A TEACHER ERROR WAS MADE. (No citizenship make-up accepted.)

COURSES

Students applying for an academic letter must complete three classes each quarter chosen from the academic areas of English, world languages, mathematics, science, or social studies.

APPLICATION

In order for a student to be considered eligible for an academic letter, he/she must complete an application form which can be obtained from the student's English teacher, and from Ms. Nicholson (room 103), or from the front office. Applications must be turned in by April 11, 2014 by 2:20 p.m. with a copy of the student's report card (or printout from gradebook) showing grades, citizenship, and GPA for each of the three terms attached.

AWARDS

The Academic letters will be awarded each year. A small assembly will be held near the end of May where recipients will receive a certificate and an academic pin, and will also receive information about purchasing a school letter and/or letter jacket or sweater. Students will be informed of where and when the assembly will be held. Those students not able to attend the assembly may pick up their certificate and pin from room 103 following the day of the assembly.
