<u>Update on current 2018-2019 budget-any need for amendment?</u> Saturday school will not be funded this year. Teachers will be observing other teachers at Kennedy, so there would be a need to fund the substitutes. A teacher survey will be sent out asking what they would like to learn/observe and then they will be matched up to teachers that do that well. This will help with goals of Instructional framework, PLC's and student engagement. No amendments will need to be made to use these funds in this manner.

<u>Turn around update:</u> A 90-day plan was just redone. The focus is on: Instructional Framework (Focus on activities) PLC's (focus on Interventions and enrichment) and Student Enrichment (Additional training and follow up.)
