In attendance: Katie Allen, Christie Rasmussen, Principal Mary Anne Stevens, Andrew Anthony, Deborah Burkholder, Eliana Sigler, Brenda Shamo and Cindy Turner

Welcome: Brenda Shamo. She also explained a few basic procedures for Community council. Agendas are posted online 1 week before meetings, so members can look over them prior to the meetings. The Chair takes care of getting those submitted and conducts meetings. The Vice Chair is needed for coverage in case the Chair is not available. Members are only able to miss 2 meetings before they are replaced.

Voting on Positions: Ms. Stevens made a motion to propose that Brenda Shamo be the committee chair. Cindy Turner gave a second and it was a unanimous vote in her favor. Brenda made a motion that Katie Allen be nominated as Vice chair, Christie Rasmussen provided the second and it was again a unanimous vote in favor of that nomination.

Meeting Schedule: There was a discussion of what days and times for meetings would accommodate all members. Tuesday was a day that everyone was available, and meetings will generally be held on the second Tuesday of the month with a few exceptions of schedule conflicts. The dates for the meetings will be October 5th, November 14th, January 9th, February 20th, March 13th, and April 10th. These meetings are open to all parents and teachers if they are interested in attending.

Business: Everyone was invited to take a yard sign to put in their yards that showed support for our public schools in Granite School District. These signs will also be available at PTC both nights. The show of support is needed due to Proposition 1 that will be on the next ballot. This is a bond proposal that will raise money for schools that are in need of repair. The website Gsd-futures.org explains the need and order of schools for repairs along with other information. It was brought to our attention from Christie Rasmussen that at the district community council meetings that the bond passing would bring up the value of our homes, keep our kids and teachers safe and in the event of a natural disaster, our buildings would become points of help and would need to be structurally sound.
