<u>Approve February minutes:</u> Mary Basso motions to approve February minutes. This motion was seconded by Caroline Mitchell; all in favor.

<u>Final Report for 2019-2020:</u> Website is not working. Landtrust website was supposed to be live in January, then it was bumped to beginning of March. It is still not working. This school year we spent 31,302 for a teacher salary. We have \$4000.00 for supplies to be spent. Technology funds were not spent due to Turnaround funds this school year and COVID.

2020-2021 Land Trust Plan: Kennedy's leadership team met and based on needs assessment created two goals.

- 1. Decrease non-proficient kids by 5% based on RISE testing
 - a. Hire instructional coach
 - b. Provide an additional 6th grade teacher to reduce class size and increase time and instruction
 - c. Provide additional student supports through English support classes and paraprofessionals to support and increase student learning time
 - d. Provide tier 1 instruction that utilizes priorities standards through a variety of student engagement strategies and common formative assessments
- 2. Increase family engagement
 - a. Home visits to 15% of population
 - b. Increase communication with families
 - i. Quarterly newsletters, virtual training, etc
 - ii. Home visits
 - c. Digital and printed handbook for parents
 - i. Step by step handbook for parents
 - 1. Food pantry hours
 - 2. Canvas instructions
 - 3. Parent Portal
 - 4. Go Math
 - 5. Community Center information
