When viewing the safe walking routes map, the green routes are the preferred routes for students to take to and from school. Students should cross at the stop light not at the canal crosswalk. Brenda Shamo will be contacting individuals to see about the potential for a large well-lit crossing for students. The construction for the sidewalk on the other side of the church needs to be applied for three years in advance. There is a small window when the applications are open.
