2. Land Trust Funds
  - a. Millions of acres of land used to help support schools
  - b. SCC looks at “How to invest?”
  - c. For many years, the Land Trust Fund was a rollover balance. Now it is used each year.
  - d. Lincoln Elementary has used funds to invest in people (added staff and training).
  - e. This year’s balance is \$37,211 for fiscal year July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017
  - f. SCC will review new budget in the spring for 2017-2018 fiscal year.
3. Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT) and Home Visit Information
  - a. Lincoln Elementary is a turnaround school through the state
  - b. APTT is a state program: It’s a new way to look at parent/teacher conferences
  - c. Meets three times a year to practice activities to take home (Oct. Feb. April)
  - d. Teachers will also schedule home visits to reach out to families.
  - e. Discuss ideas on how to advertise APTT nights as well as home visits for families.
  - f. Turnaround update: Lincoln’s school grade had been released and improvement has been seen each year. In the last three years, Lincoln has improved from a Letter F to D to C.
