Minutes on Lincoln Website

- Milton spoke with Ashley about putting the Community Council Minutes on the school website and she can do it
- Laura will email Milton the minutes

Lincoln in 3rd year of turnaround status (bottom 3%)

- How did we get here? What do we need to do to get out?
- Current school grade D
 - To get to a C, we need to increase scores 7% (from 37% to 44%) and 41 points
 - If we increase one letter grade, Lincoln gets \$100 per student and \$1,000 per educator
- School transformation team met and decided to have a schoolwide focus on writing as most effective way to raise school grade
 - Today's PD will be teachers sharing ideas for writing strategies
- What happens if Lincoln doesn't get out of turnaround status by year 3?
 - According to verbiage, state can come in and take over the school
 - However, due to school making progress, likelihood of moving administration/teachers is low

SAGE testing

- Takes place in April
- School grade based on Proficiency as well as Growth

Board approved new boundaries next year

- Next year Lincoln will get an additional 120 students from Woodrow Wilson (will be bused)
- Where to put possible classrooms: computer lab, preschool, post high in the north wing, rels
 - Milton will fight to keep all the kids in the main school space
- Steve Hogan will be invited to next Community Council meeting to discuss school boundaries, solutions for space, etc.
- Important to fight to keep class sizes low
