Notes/Minutes:

- Parent expressed concern about punishments in sixth grade being given as group punishments.
 - Kids should feel safe, noticed, and good here.
 - Kids are reporting that they don't want to report because they don't want their friends mad at them, or they're afraid of what will happen to them if they do tell.
 - Parent reported that their student feels brave when she's with him.
- Possible solutions:
 - clear boundary marker on the playground (cones and caution tape)
 - post on Dojo about parent volunteers for playground if they don't want the commitment of a paid position
 - shower the sixth grade students with food rewards (pretzels, gold fish, skittles, etc.)
 - buddies - lower buddies and high school buddies
 - suggestion boxes in each classroom for reporting
 - when 6th grade students are returned from office referral have a quick chat with teacher about repairing harm and consequences
- Revisit in November meeting
- The council decided to move all other discussion items to the November meeting because the parent concern discussion took a good bit of time, but was worth the time.
