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Notes/Minutes:

- Follow-up on parent concerns:
  - Julie Bunk reported that food has been implemented in the classrooms and it is working well! It keeps them on task and it keeps them motivated. They have been talking about that the students need to learn how to be friends with each other/ be kind to each other.
    - Parents have been awesome at donating food/snacks for students.
  - Kinder buddies have not been established yet, but students are interested in being kinder buddies.
  - Visual boundary in the middle of the field has not been established, but sixth grade has been respecting the boundary of staying on the lower-grade playground and not going past that.
  - Sixth grade students are now receiving individualized consequences.
    - Teachers are following through with positive and negative consequences.
    - Sixth grade has implemented a “Kool Kids” program which is a positive incentives program for students to earn. They get a chance to earn it every week.
- DCC:
  - Ashley Hammond will be our official DCC contact
    - Our awesome parents will split the remaining 3 meetings.
- Crosswalk update:
  - Misty Boyd has gotten new information that there are new federal requirements that must be met in order to access the \$25,000 grant. The school would need to contribute around \$1,700 to access the rest of the funding.
  - The council had a lively conversation about pros and cons about moving forward with the grant.
    - Misty is going to follow up with the grant people to get some additional information.
  - The council will continue this conversation next month with the new information Misty gets.
  - Paige is thinking PTA might be able to help with the money the school needs to contribute. April is going to bring it up at the next PTA meeting. She is thinking they can use the first \$1,700 of their fundraiser for crosswalk money.
- The council voted to talk about digital citizenship at the next meeting.
