Notes/Minutes:

- Safe technology and digital citizenship:
 - White Ribbon Week We could do small reminders instead of a big week of stuff.
 - Parent handouts would be appreciated because technology is different now and they're not sure how to keep their kiddos safe.
 - Adult only dinner? Do we want to tie it into P.I.E. day? (March 14th)
 - Ashley is going to do some research to see if there's a district person that can do a short (30 minutes or less) presentation for the parents BEFORE they go visit the classrooms. In the classrooms, students can show their parents the online programs they use at school. For students without adults that come, they can continue an activity assigned by their teacher. If all else fails, we can ask Barbara Sanders to do the parent presentation.
 - After an informative discussion the council has decided to try safe technology and digital citizenship in with P.I.E. day.
- Indoor recess temperature:
 - The council discussed how currently the lunch recess is "called" by the office, but the morning and afternoon recess can be "called" by the grade level teacher if they're willing to go out.
 - April will make sure teachers know they have the option to still take students out for morning and/or afternoon recess if they're willing to go out with them.
- LandTrust funds for next year:
 - The council discussed how those funds are being used in the 2022-2023 school year.
 - Funds are being used to pay for paraeducators.
 - They discussed possibly keeping the money going toward paraeducators so teachers have support for core subjects.
