2019 Proficiency Data	Dawn Hauser	Growth from RISE Secondary Math 1 last year the majority of students were a 4. Provided ENCORE Growth Scores. Anything approaching 70 is high growth. Matheson MGP is 51.5 (District provided numbers with Benchmark Data). World Language is 36.25. Social Studies is 67. Ms. Larkin had the highest MGP in the junior high social studies. Reading Inventory Growth Summary passed out (September and March). Average growth 79. Goal: Average of 100 points per year. 7th grade 114 points 8th grade 40. RISE proficiency data Math is close to proficient 7th grade 23.1 percent proficient. Decrease 2 percent from the year before. 8th grade from 17 to 18 percent. Growth is very important it is what we measure. ELA fell short 7th grade improved 4 percentage points from 17 to 21.5. 8th	Continue to emphasize growth
