3. Review Budget: We currently have a balance of 35,489 in our account however we can only carry over 10% to a new school year. Hiring for paraprofessionals has been difficult with the labor shortage and we haven't had many applicants. Principal plans to reach out to members of the Spanish speaking community to see if there is any interest in filling the positions. Since we cannot carry over more than the 10%, we should begin forming a backup plan for our funds in January. There is a lengthy process to get this approved. We could look at revamping our school library books and purchase more books especially those in Spanish. A library assessment could be conducted to see what our needs are.

Megan is concerned about 1100 e not having automatic crossing lights for the crosswalk. We will check to see who is responsible for this road, county or city.
