Meeting Tasks:

1. **Welcome.** Guests in attendance: Amaryah Cannon (PTA president), Steve Hogan (GSD), Ben Horsley (GSD), Dana Breeze (GSD admin assistant), Julie Jackson (School board).
2. **Review and Approve February Minutes.** Motion to approve by Angie, Seconded by Freya. Unanimously approved.
3. **Boundary Study** by Steve Hogan and Ben Horsley. As stated in a previous meeting, Davis demographics company has been working closely with GSD as student population is declining around the district. The process for a boundary study is state law and no decisions are made yet as the process takes an entire calendar year. This study is called "Van Winkle/700 east boundary and consolidation study". We know that 4-5 teachers per grade is ideal and school choice/open enrollment affects enrollment numbers district and state wide. School funding is based on FTE hours so the more students there are at a school, the more staff and more money a school will get. The entire corridor is being studied to see if any school could be closed, consolidated and or boundaries changed. There will be public meetings in April that everyone is encouraged to attend. April 11th at Cottonwood High, April 13th at Granite Park Jr High, and April 18th at Olympus High. 4. **Review current budget snapshot** Reviewed amended plan for use of this years funds. Could purchase about 7 electronic blackboards with the funds and use any ESSER money as needed for install. Sonya motioned to approve, Freya seconded. Unanimous approval.

5. Review drafted plan for LAND trust funds for 2022-2023 school year. Plan was reviewed for usage 2022-2023 funds to fund a half time STEM teacher. Angie motioned to approve, Megan seconded. Unanimous approval.

6. Discuss and approve temperature policy for outdoor play. Plan presented by Ms. Clayton with the lower temperature as 24 including wind chill. Discussed air quality limits as well with red air days being no outdoor play and any other color day, children can stay inside by parent request. Motion to approve by Megan. Seconded by Rebekah. Unanimously approved.

7. Staffing plan was present to the council by Ms. Clayton. She noted that the teachers already unanimously approved the plan in their last meeting. Freya motioned to approve, Angie seconded and council unanimously approved.
