The current land trust plan shows growth in ELA and looking at pathways of progress for reading. Ily is clarifying we will have a mid year POP goal that will make sure we are on track to meet the end of the year goal for 1st and 3rd grade.

Action steps we need to make sure we are focusing on higher level and bubble students. We have Mondeaux as our interventionist, and Barnum both part time. They are helping our 1st and 2nd graders, some that have never been in school, some students didn't know any letters sounds. We need to hire a para educator to help in the classroom in 1st grade. We have \$72k and only half of it is being used. Milne would like to use the extra funds for current para's and then use the Title 1 funds for new para's. The committee agreed and we don't have to adjust or amend the plan to make these changes.
