- \$1.5k- transportation to Tanner Dance performance
- \$11k- Teacher summer PLC

- Request for field sprinklers to not be on while students are coming to school. Anne will speak with Becky about the sprinkler schedule
 - Question was raised about band/orchestra before school and not during the school day. Music was removed from district budgets many years ago, all band/orchestra lessons are sub-contracted through Riverton Music and are before school. Music is an optional service for Morningside students.
 - Connor made the council aware of a skatepark lighting fundraiser for Holladay City, school can post on website and have a poster in the office. Flyers for students must get an Access Card from Ben Horsely's office.
