Principals Report

Land Trust 2017-2018 Updates and spending

DIBELS- Nice growth thus far, especially 1st grade

Math- Increased overall proficiency by 35 %

Budget- Right on par with spending allocation

Draft Land Trust 2018- 2019

Teacher Survey- Christine asked how LT money would best be spent (9 teachers responded).

The top two results were substitutes for PLC days and class aides followed by mores star readers, technology, stem supplies and recess aides.

Substitutes for PLC days- Christine suggests increasing the PLC time by 6 days per years in the 2018 2019 Land Trust Plan and implementing a student support team that can meet to address ways to help struggling students during daytime hours every 6 weeks.

Summary- We will funnel money out of the Technology budget and into creating more PLC

days. We also discuss funding a day for Chantelle to meet with teachers to dove tale the STEM curriculum with the core.
