School Schedule
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Regular classroom instruction will take place on a Monday through Friday schedule.</li><li>• School Hours: Monday through Thursday 8:40 a.m. - 3:20 p.m., Friday or Planning Day 8:40 a.m. - 1:15 p.m.</li><li>• Office Hours: Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.</li><li>• Meetings such as IEPs, 504s, SEPs, etc. may be in-person or virtual based on preference and availability.</li></ul>
Monitoring Symptoms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students/staff who are demonstrating ANY symptom of COVID-19 must stay home.</li><li>• Keep contact numbers current as parents will be contacted by the school demonstrating symptoms.</li><li>• Case counts will be monitored by the county health department dashboard.</li><li>• Students or staff that are exposed to COVID-19 will work with the health department regarding quarantine. Those who are exposed will NOT be quarantined if: they had a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 90 days, have been fully vaccinated, the positive individual and the exposed individual were both wearing masks at the time of exposure, or if non-immunized wear a mask for 10 days following exposure.</li><li>• Our goal is to keep children healthy while attending school in-person.</li></ul>
Masks
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Per health department recommendations, masks are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED for all students and staff while indoors, but NOT required.</li><li>• Masks will be available to students and staff upon request.</li><li>• Harassment in any form, directed either at those who wear face coverings or those who choose not to, will not be tolerated.</li></ul>
Enhanced Environment Hygiene and Safety
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Schools will remain mindful of cleanliness to the highest degree possible.</li><li>• Hospital grade air filtration and circulation (up to four times per hour) will continue.</li><li>• Cleaning and disinfecting of high touch surfaces will occur throughout the day.</li><li>• Hand sanitizer will be available.</li></ul>
Social Distancing
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In all areas of our school, we will remain mindful of safe spacing to the highest degree possible.</li><li>• Cohorts of students will be maintained to the greatest extent possible in all areas of the school to ensure student safety.</li><li>• Seating will be assigned in classrooms and the lunchroom.</li></ul>

- Nonessential furniture and equipment has been moved out of rooms to increase the distancing footprint.
- One class will enter or exit the building at a time to minimize the number of students in confined areas.
- Staff will monitor and minimize congregation of students during transitions.
- Before school and after recess, students will line up by class at their grade level designated door and stand on dots to stay spaced out appropriately.
- The number of individuals in the restroom during non-scheduled times will be minimal with no more than 3 in the bathroom at a time.
- Floor markings signify places for students to stand while waiting to be served lunch or to use the restroom.
- Only one grade level will eat at a time, thus reducing the number of students seated at a table.
- Signage is posted around the building to remind patrons and students of guidelines regarding physical distancing.
- Grade level students will be assigned an area of play, which will be rotated each day.
- Assemblies will be held in small groups or through video.
