1a. By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, at least 80% of students will make typical or above-typical progress according to their Pathways of Progress goal on Acadience Math. Student numeracy will be monitored through Acadience Math Middle of Year assessment and progress monitoring.	2a. At the end of the 2022-2023 school year, there will be a 10% reduction in the overall number of office disciplinary referrals compared to the number that occurred during the 2021-2022 school year.	3a. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, all school employees (classroom teachers, coaches, administrator, etc.) will have reached two of their outlined PG&E goals.
1b. At least 88% of students will be at or above benchmark as measured by the 2022-2023 End of Year Acadience Reading assessment. Student literacy will be monitored through Acadience Reading Middle of Year assessment and progress monitoring.		
1c. Compared to schoolwide performance on the 2021 RISE, students' average test performance on the 2023 Math RISE will increase by 9% to a schoolwide proficiency rate of 76%.
