Council Business

1. -Approve minutes from January mtg. made by Heidi and seconded by Brian P.
2. -Reviewed Middle of year student data for Acadience POP and benchmark for reading and math. Looked at school data for I-Ready Diagnostic growth percentages and the percentages of students above/on grade level and below grade level.
3. -Discussion on school needs. Looked at last year's school climate survey results. Oakridge strengths: Focusing on individual student needs, communication, emphasis on character education, opportunities for students to be involved in leadership roles, Steam and art focuses. Oakridge needs: Focus on math more. The council would like to see more integration and creativity in classrooms and grades and rotations among grade level teams.
4. -Land Trust Plan estimated funds for 23-24 \$43,491.92 Continual improvement plan goal and focus discussion. The council discussed using the funds to hire a part-time instructional coach to work with the teachers. This will help us support our teachers and get the most growth in our school. Mrs. Bergera shared the results of a teacher survey regarding coaching.
5. -Safe walking route was approved. The council would like to advocate for sidewalks on the bottom of Jupiter since there is a lot of traffic on that road.
6. -Discussed scams happening with SCC emails and contact information. Scammers are getting the email addresses off of websites for SCC members and contacting them, posing as the principal, and asking for help purchasing gift cards online, etc. Principals will never ask council members to purchase gift cards for them.
