Our goal for Acadience reading was to have 88% of our students scoring at or above benchmark by the end of the year. It looks like we could be close to whether or not we meet this goal.

Academic Goals:

1. On the 2024 RISE assessments, school MGP in all subjects will increase to 70 or greater.

2. At least 75% of students will achieve the median percent progress towards typical growth on the I-Ready Diagnostic assessment.

Social and Emotional Goal:

Students' Self-Management: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, at least 80% of students will report that they can manage their emotions, thoughts, and behaviors in different situations.

Calming corners in all classrooms

- Restorative questions:
 - What happened?
 - What were you thinking of at the time? What spot of emotion did you feel?
 - What have you thought about since?
 - Who has been affected by what you have done?
 - In what way have they been affected? What spot of emotion do you think they felt?
 - What do you think you need to do to make things right?

There will be at least 2 coaching cycles occurring each month, including a pre-coaching conversation, coaching event, and debrief.
