
## News from our Cafeteria



# **Proficiency-Based Learning (PBL)**

### PBL provides an increased emphasis on Core Standards in three ways:



Focused teaching of core standards.



Collecting evidence of student learning on core standards.



Reporting student progress on core standards.

#### Why PBL?

PBL helps the District better understand and communicate students' strengths and areas for growth, which provides better data to use in determining where student supports and/ or learning extensions are needed.

#### Recency

PBL uses the most recent evidence of student learning to determine the proficiency score on a specific standard. This allows for student growth over time during the instructional sequence.
