- 1. Welcome, Roll call of attendees was taken and review and unanimous approval of the Minutes was entered by the Council
- 2. Handbook Distribution:

Tod indicated that the District IT department is working on a template for all the school websites, so we will anticipate the update for that. In the meantime, Tod will work with School Tech Specialist about any other issues to keep accessibility for the school employees and streamline accounts if possible.
- 6. Parking Issues & Concerns

Nate reported that Ted Hatch did talk with Brandon Bevan regarding the parking lot issue and Watch Dog Dads program in the mornings. No current plans to start that program again. The Dad program was helpful but often distracting as some dads stayed after school started and played with their children on playground, etc. Discussion among council as to more signs, use of crosswalk, having parents or staff with a nametag confront the parking offenders and ask them to move or hand them a copy of the parking lot policy. Council will observe the lot and also how other schools re handling this issue. Safety of the students is the priority.
