Motion to Approve November Minutes -Chelsea Dye, Karen Oliver, 2nd motion; All approved.

<u>Kindergarten Outreach</u> - Thank you Nichole Kirkland for a wonderful flyer. Eric had it printed by the District and used Land Trust funds as approved last meeting. Barbara Luka took them to:

Mother's Helper, Early Birds' PreSchool, Shining Stars Academy, Kinder Landing, La Petite Academy, Children's Montessori Garden, and Holladay PreSchool. They will still be taken to Lion Academy, Children's Cottage, Mt. Olympus Presbyterian, and Compass PreSchool in Murray and Cottonwood Heights.

Eric's extension effort -

- 1. Send this flyer home with students for referrals. Snapshots of teachers and programs printed on the back side. Barbara suggested an "At A Glance" and work on a referral system. This flyer sent home will be communicated to parents by teachers using each communication system for their classes.
- 2. Include mailer on social media Instagram and Facebook. Expect this to happen the week of Feb 1, 2022
- 3. Eric will change the title to "2022-23" instead of "Kindergarten" to capture all grade interest.
- 4. Open House will be postponed for the future, closer to April so those already registered can plan to attend.
- 5. Priority Enrollment ends February 17 and the District works with student numbers between February 17 and March 1st so principals can plan teacher assignments for 2022-23.

Targeted Ad buys - Jonathan Davies explained Facebook advertising prices start low and increase depending on target audience and reach goals. You indeed to identify the target audience and goal. It is hard to track a small campaign. Tabled advertising effort until next month.

Barbara Luka suggested including a question on the registration form asking how they heard of Oakwood. It already asks what preschool they attended.

Continual Improvement Plan - Congratulations to Tanya Roller and Zoe Bowen for achieving the second highest middle of the year Improvement in Reading in the district! 35%!

Eric wants everyone to look over the Continual Improvement Plan and discuss at next month's meeting. It is found on the URS website. The district can show data over time for 3 years. Be careful in looking at the numbers as there was not end of the year testing in 2020.

Land Trust Funds - Decide how to spend these funds from now to the end of the year. Eric's teacher poll showed support for:

Social Emotional Learning class for students. This would bring a teacher to Oakwood to teach 1-2 times a week for all students. Eric is looking for a social worker to hire for this position. Land Trust pays ½ and the District picks up the rest.

Interactive Media Center - Oakwood's new librarians, Heidi Reed and Deborah Brady are ready to develop this program. They will focus on: student research skills among other items.

Tanner Dance - \$12,000 per year. Oakwood needs to measure its effectiveness. Suggestions were a pre and post assessment for content focused on per class. Tiffany suggested also measuring movement and motor skills, confidences, and Chelsea suggested to have students articulate their social emotional skills.

Audio-Visual needs in the classrooms - Eric spoke to the District person in charge of AV. Smart Boards are being phased out. Parts are hard to find. The BoxLight - 86", iPad-like is replacing them. Granger Elementary has them and Eric is going to check them out Friday. They connect to the teacher's computer. Teachers will use a laptop with it and then can move around the classroom. This is a multi year plan. Eric is thinking about having a few teachers test drive a BoxLight next year, and then they will be implemented over time. Jonathan suggested asking teachers how they use their Smart Boards currently.

Wifi Boost - Eric is meeting with Verizon to use ESSR funds to boost Oakwood's wifi.

Duties/Tasks:

- Barbara and Karen will finish distributing Kindergarten flyers.
- Eric to create a referral system on the back of the "referral flyer" changed for all grades and to be sent home next week.
- All Community Council members read the Continual Improvement Plan found on the URS website.
