Blended School Plan Updates	Safe Walking Routes -consider challenges of safe walking routes -Goal is for Community Council to walk routes to ensure safety - Need to go to the City to explain need to expand school zone and get more school guards -School zone coming North starts right at school -Needs to be crossing guard further south of Fardown on Highland because it is a 40 Mph road -North school zone moved North of Cecelia road (sidewalk is narrow)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Many parents park at the LDS church south of Oakwood and students walk over so we need 1 or 2 crossing guards at corner of church and Highland -Ensure signs are facing north and south -1.5 miles from the school go on bus -April 25th we will get bus routes -We need to ask transportation to identify what portion of students attend in the northern end of new Oakwood boundaries for the bus/walking routes <p>Front Parking Lot safety</p> <p>Issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -3 lanes go to 2 at corner -corner by Kinder playground is a jam -parents stop at corner instead of pulling forward <p>Solutions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -cone off portions of the lanes so that only prek and kinder can pull near curb -prek enter main doors, teachers meet at main doors and parents drop off outside main doors, have dots for kids to line up on by flag pole -add crosswalk near kinder? (could backup onto Highland) -Divert cars through second driveway behind first row of parking in main lot and cone off the 2 lanes that go straight -Sending note home to Prek to tell them to park in lot and walk over? -Parents need to know kids can go around either side of the school to the back -Faculty only in North lot -No Faculty in front rows in main lot -Having Prek go through main doors would help with safety and parents couldn't come in with their kids -When entering parking lot from Highland, left lane goes right into parking lot, second lane goes into second row in parking lot far right lane goes straight against curb, block lanes with cones to direct cars -add lines -Safety patrol have poles to direct kids and cars <p>Other items coming up in our community</p>
