    - -Concerns about class size in Second Grade (currently at 27) especially if students leave DLI
    - -If DLI students want to go out of DLI then there will be a process with Student Support team

\*Public notice should be made of the fall elections with an invitation for interested persons to become candidates, qualifications of candidacy and membership, declaration due date, location of declaration forms, and voter instructions.

<u>Please note</u>: Parent or guardian positions must be filled by someone who will have a student enrolled at the school at any time during their 2-year term.

At your May meeting, you must identify those open parent positions. Parent positions are 2-year terms, that should be staggered. This means that 50% of your parent positions should be open for election on any given year. It may be necessary to have a one-year term(s), to get in compliance.

Council size is determined by each individual school. Patrons members should outnumber employee members by 2.

### DATES TO NOTE:

Thursday, August 17, 2023 -- Declaration of Candidacy Due to Principal by 3 PM

Friday, August 18, 2023 – Schools notify Darla either that they do not need to hold an election, or send the completed Candidate Information for Online Elections form.

Monday, August 21, 2023 – (For schools holding online elections only) – electronic ballots sent to school to be distributed.

Tuesday, August 22 -- Thursday, August 24, 2023 - Online Elections held for those schools who need it Tuesday, August 29 - Election results sent to schools
