
OAKWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HOME OF THE OWLS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

 - a. Follow up to last month's concern by teachers on feeling anxious due to the variety of learning levels of our students (academically and behaviorally)

- 5. Current issues and determine action steps
 - a. What are our current community concerns we need to address?
 - i. Safety of parents/students on Highland Drive, Fardown during drop off and pick up
 - 1. Thank you to Holladay City, Granite School Board, and District Superintendency for their help and support to brainstorm and come up with solutions.
 - 2. A crossing guard has been placed at Fardown
 - 3. No Parking signs have been placed on Highland Drive
 - 4. Traffic congestion heading northbound on the east lane is a safety concern. Traffic is backing up while people are waiting to enter drop off. First step is to educate drivers and then citations may be issued. There have been some issues with school zone lights. These will be double-checked to ensure they are in working order.
 - 5. Snow removal will be done to the church for drop off/pickup
 - 6. PTA offered to help with traffic when snow season begins
 - ii. What data do we want to collect on our Traditional and DLI programs this year to better serve our entire student body?
 - 1. DLI has brought amazing students to Oakwood, very few students have asked to be removed from DLI program so far this year
 - 2. If a student requests to leave the DLI program there is a process the student must go through before they are allowed to leave the DLI program.

- 3. Eric is hoping to have 50-60 students enroll in DLI for first grade for next year. There are currently 29 DLI students enrolled in first grade this year. Ideally first grade would have two classes that are DLI and two classes that are traditional.
- 4. Marketing is a way to attract DLI students. Granite can't market specifically for our school alone, only the DLI program in general.
- 5. Oakridge's capacity is 600 students. Marketing could be used to attract students to the DLI program. Flyers and videos will be made to share with the community to attract new DLI students.
- iii. What other items of concern does the council wish to address?
 - 1. We are 1.5 over FTE. Granite School District ESR money is financing the 1.5 FTE for this year, but this is the last year for this funding. The funding was guaranteed to Oakwood for two years.
 - In order for current DLI to succeed we need three Chinese teachers and three traditional teachers. Julie Jackson and Clark Nelson have been great supporters of Oakwood. Next year the decision will be made to either continue DLI or discontinue it.
 - 3. Collect data on class sizes and students continuing on with DLI program
 - 4. Rethink how we reach out for parent help/volunteers
