5. Middle of year test results

-i-Ready Math Middle of the Year (MOY) diagnostic results. i-Ready is an adaptive test and is quite challenging. Oakwood showed great growth on the MOY assessment. Wendy Jones is paid through LAND Trust Funds as a full-time School Technology Specialist (STS) and has been used to help direct interventionists. The i-Ready MOY scores show that having Wendy full-time is an effective use of LAND Trust resources.

-Acadience Reading (DIBELS) MOY scores. Overall, Oakwood scored well. Four out of six grade levels scored above Granite School District recommended benchmark of 60%. Using MOY data to guide student needs, interventionists will now focus on kindergarten and first grade. By giving students a strong foundation, it will eventually benefit the upper grades. DYAD reading interventions for other grades will increase.




Math 2023 - 2024 Most Recent Window 1
