Community council teacher reps will report back next month for how faculty would like this money spent. Land Trust salary pays for Jessica Stearn (reading volunteer coordinator) and Wendy Jones (technology coach).

- a. Oakwood teaches SEL (social emotional learning). COVID not only affected core subjects but SEL. Oakwood saw 5% drop in positive feelings from Fall 2023 to Winter 2023-24, this was the greatest drop in all areas. 2% is considered a notable change. Teacher-student relationships saw the greatest increase.
- b. Oakwood ranks 80-90th percentile in 7/7 measured areas.




COVID related Learning Loss (LL) affected more than just CORE subjects such as Math, Science, ELA, & Social Studies.

COVID related LL also occurred in Social - Emotional Learning areas as well. Ex. Self-Efficacy, Resilience, Social Skills, Sense of Belonging.


- How did students perceive their own social-emotional skills?



- How did students perceive their own social-emotional skills?




Greatest Decrease...or is it?




Free Response Wordle


