Community Council Meeting minutes

May 14th

- Angelee Luther, new Oakwood Principal in attendance
- Approved minutes from last month's meeting, no changes
- Reviewed next year's community council members, some seats are open and need to be filled. Meet the teacher on Aug 9th 3:30-5:30pm is a great opportunity to find more parent involvement for community council. Council members will have a table to find volunteers.
- Community council meetings will change to the third Thursday of each month for 24-25 school year.
- Reviewed teacher placement by grade level. Teacher input was obtained during the placement process.
- Question: Are second and third grade students going to do rotations in traditional classrooms? Grades are undecided until students get placed for next year.
- Went over master schedule: focus is on literacy and master plan has small group built into the schedule. Grouping of grades was to accommodate 504 and IEP file students with teachers for small group. Kinder specials are in the afternoon so that ½ day kinder students get required instruction.
- Looked at possible scenarios for 2025-2026 school year focusing on the needs of traditional classes and DLI to balance the needs of the students.
- Community council is interested in growing not only the Chinese DLI but other language classes at Bonneville. Will ask district to continue to invest in the DLI program. Two years committed support is insufficient to see the program succeed.
- Community council interested in holding district accountable to how they are supporting DLI programs in general.
- How can we find and apply for grants to support paraeducators to support MLL students in addition to Imagine Learning.
