\* **Tickets** for dances go on sale one week before the dance. Most tickets will be purchased online at the school's ticketing site (see school website for link)

A current **student ID** is required for entry into ALL dances, whether held at Olympus or off-campus. If an ID is lost, a new one can be created at the Bookstore for \$5.

\* Students can get into any **home Region football or basketball game** for free with their current student ID. Non-Region games are \$5 per student. Athletic entry fees are set by the Utah High School Activities Association, not by the school. Football and Basketball are the only two sports where there is a charge to attend.

\* **Dance Contract** = a contract completed and signed by the student, the student's parent, the guests Administrator and an Olympus Administrator. Allows the student to bring a date from another school. All dates must currently be attending high school and must present their school's student ID to get into the dance.

\* **Be Strong** is an award winning, PTA sponsored program at Olympus that focuses on students physical, mental and emotional health, and doing service for others. Occasional "forums" are held with guest speakers.
