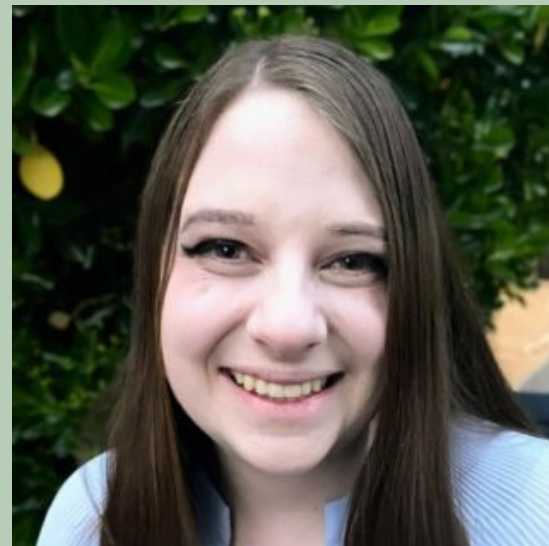

Concurrent Enrollment

- A college class taken at high school.
- Student registers with college and earns high school and college grade.

Advanced Placement

- A college-Level class.
- Students can earn college credit if they pass the AP exam at the end of the year.
- *Credit varies by university

ASPIRE

Testing starts in April



- State required test - taken in class
- Tests on English, Reading, Math, and Science
- Best prediction for the ACT score

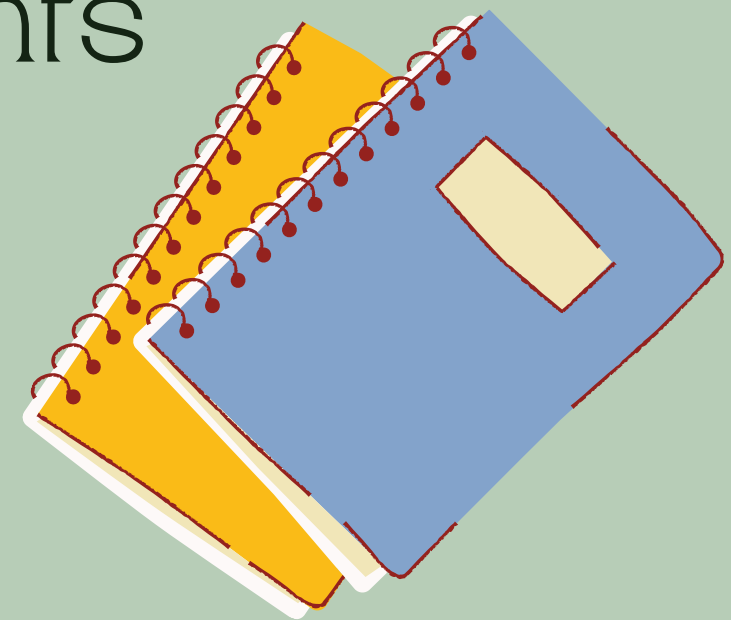


Opportunity Scholarship

- Earn a 3.3 Cumulative GPA
- Complete one AP or CE course in each of the following areas:
 - Math
 - Science
 - English
- Complete the Free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Graduate from High School
- Complete the scholarship application in your senior year.

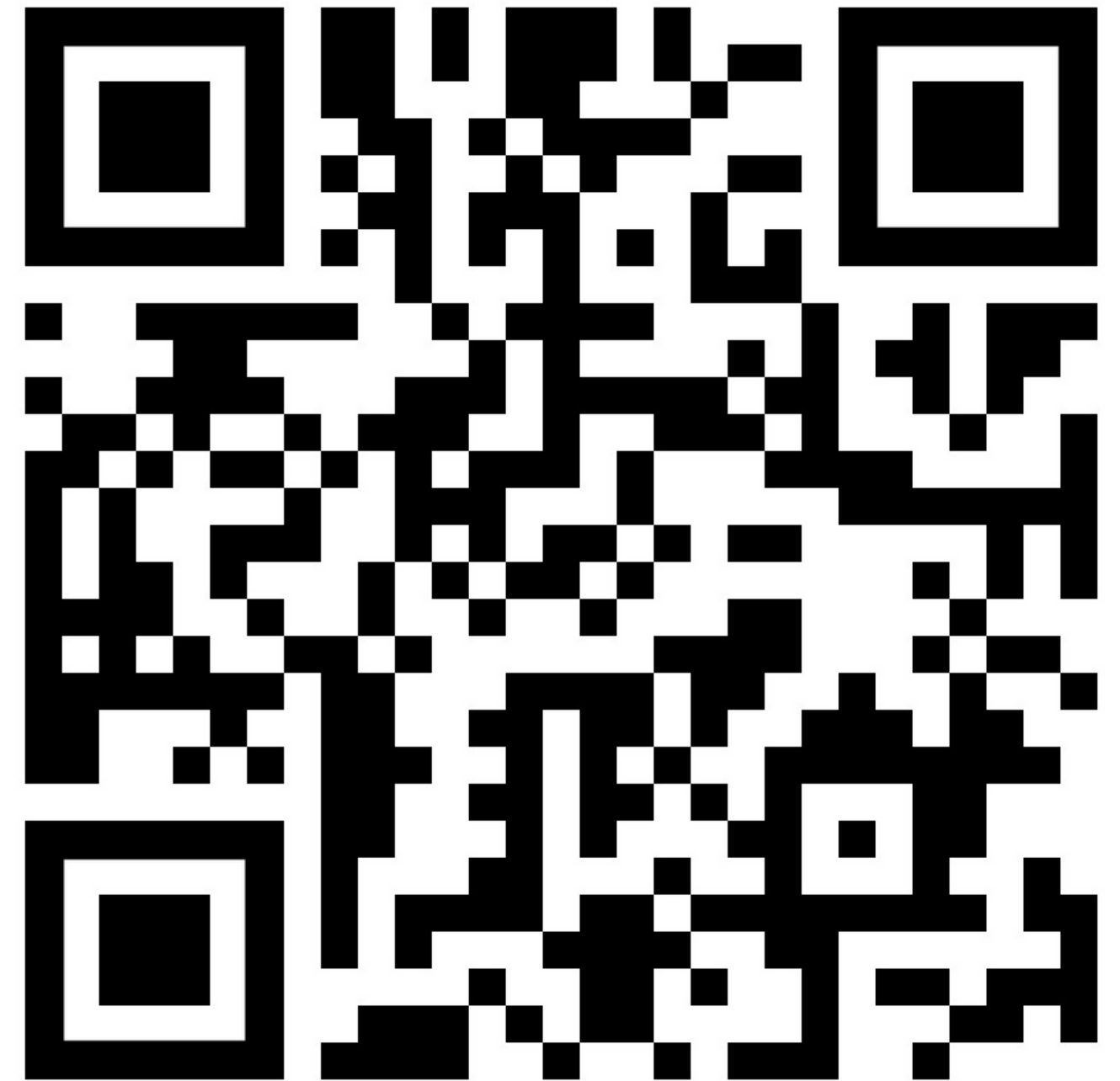
