

**Olympus Jr. High Community Council**  
**February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013 – minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Janene Davis. The January minutes were approved by the council.

Mr. Chard talked about registration for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. They will be going into classes in February through the beginning of March. The counselors have been visiting the 6<sup>th</sup> graders in the feeder elementary schools for 7<sup>th</sup> grade registration.

Carole Harris talked about CRT scores in comparison to nearby schools of Churchill, Wasatch and Bonneville. Olympus Jr. students are doing well. The council asked Ms. Harris to bring the results showing the trending for the last 3-5 years so that they could see the improvements being made by the students and faculty.

Ms. Harris reported on the measures the administration is taking on safety. The administration is sending out a letter to the families of Olympus Jr. explaining the safety changes they are making and how it will affect them. All parents must go to the administrative office to check in with the staff before they are allowed in the school. This letter to the parents will go out immediately.

There was discussion of how to communicate better with the parents and the community. Emily Ott was assigned to get information to Emily Gygi for the newsletter. It is also an opportunity to post dates of our meetings and other information which is also on the school's website.

Dress code was addressed. Kristy Wachter sent a letter addressing this. We will follow up with her on the letter and her ideas.

Finally the size of the community council was addressed. At this time it was voted unanimously to have the council stay the same size of five parents and 2 faculty members and the principal. In the fall during elections this will come to another vote if there are more parents that want to be involved. There will be three positions open on the council in the fall. Of course, the community council meetings are always open to any interested parents or community members.
