



DRESS CODE

Olympus Junior High School Administration

The dress policy applies to all students. Clothing and appearance must be safe, clean, modest, and non-disruptive to the learning environment. Students may wear Olympus Junior High or high school uniform jerseys as long as they meet dress code standards. It is expected that parents, students and staff will support the school in providing an environment where students can focus on academic learning.

WHAT CAN I WEAR OR NOT WEAR?

The dress standards at Olympus Junior High School stipulate the following:

- 3 finger rule for tank tops. No visible bra straps, no spaghetti strap tops.
- **NO** crop tops or bare midriffs. Shirts must **NOT** show cleavage.
- Coats or bulky outer wear must be kept in locker during school hours.
- If wearing sheer top, clothing worn over or underneath must be dress code appropriate.
- **NO** hats or bandanas.
- **NO** shorts, dresses or skirts shorter than three inches above the top of the knee cap.
- If wearing holes in jeans, skin can show through the holes at or below the knee, but not above the knee.
- If leggings are worn with mesh panels, the mesh panels **must not** rise beyond the 3-inch limit above the knee cap.
- **NO** drug, alcohol, sexual or violent references are allowed in logos, wording or images.
- **NO** sagging pants.
- **NO** visible underwear.
- **NO** pajamas, or blankets.
- **NO** slippers. Shoes must be worn as a pair.
- **NO** pocket chains of any type. Belts must be looped through the belt loops and must not hang.
- **NO** backpacks (including string backpacks) or over the arm bags are allowed in classrooms. All backpacks and bags must be kept in lockers during the school day.

The administration reserves the right to amend the dress code and any or all articles in the student handbook.

Consequences:

- 1 Verbal warning, change of clothes, parent contact
- 2 One lunch detention, parent contact
- 3 Two lunch detentions parent contact
- 4 Out of school suspension, parent meeting
