**Principal's Report: 2018-2019 LAND Trust Plan** will need to be approved by March 21<sup>st</sup>. Mr. Wagstaff agreed to send the 2017-18 plan to everyone and Council members can workshop ideas in email. Mr. Wagstaff will ask teachers and staff where they think are areas of highest priority for this funding and will report to council members in email before the next community council meeting. Once email workshopping has taken place, Mr. Wagstaff will come to our next meeting on March 12 with a rough draft to discuss. If further discussion is needed of the plan, we will call another meeting before the March 21<sup>st</sup> deadline. We should plan to have at least \$91,000 of funding for the 2018-19 year.

**Council Member Items: Enrichment Activities:** Principal Wagstaff informed the council on how this is working and on how students and teachers seem to be responding. Some recent

Enrichment Activities include folk dancing, history trivia, history of rock & roll, career opportunities (30 parents volunteered for this one!), and connection of sports and geography. There was much discussion around the topic of how Teacher Advisory period works and its structure.

**Olympus Network Reconfiguration:** The council determined that it would like to know where other schools stand on this issue. We determined that we know that Olympus High, Evergreen Junior High, Olympus Junior High, and Cottonwood Elementary have all sent in letters requesting the opening of the information gathering stage. Mr. Wagstaff committed to asking Driggs where they are at, Tina Seastrand will ask Rosecrest, and Julie Jackson will ask William Penn.

**District Community Council Meeting:** Julie Jackson shared voting statistics from the district's recent bond approval.
