Approval of April Minutes: Robert Brough motioned for approval, Julie Jackson seconded, All in Favor.

Principal's Report: Grant Items: Four grant applications were reviewed. One for paying for buses to take students on a field trip to an art exhibit. Three were to pay for teachers to stay after school to give extra help to students. Julie Jackson motioned to approve all four grants, Tina Seastrand seconded, and all were in favor.

Principal's Report: Advisory Recruiting and Peer Mentoring: Principal Wagstaff informed the council on how this is working and on how students and teachers seem to be responding.

Principal's Report: School Ratings discussion was tabled until the next Community Council Meeting.

LAND Trust plan review: Principal Wagstaff announced that Trust Lands funds went out to pay for our teachers Nuts and Bolts training over the summer. 80 % of our staff came for training and for Advisory prep days, both of which were paid for by Trust Lands funds. Staff gave tremendous feedback about the usefulness of the training.

SSAP Plan review and vote: Having been briefed on the school's SSAP plan, the council agreed that they would benefit from more time to become educated with the SSAP and from the opportunity to compare this year's plan with last year's plan. The council determined to table this issue and to reschedule our December meeting to November 27th at 3:15 pm so that we might vote on this issue before the SSAP is due on November 29th.

Council Member Items: Paying for a 19 hour/week aide for the overburdened PE classes: Tabled until the next meeting.

Olympus Network Reconfiguration: It was determined that Olympus High School needs to have an official letter from our council requesting that we begin the process of information

gathering about reconfiguration. The council agreed that Tina Seastrand would write a letter of request for us and that we could vote on sending it at the next meeting.
