1. Review and approval of November 27, 2017 Minutes: John motioned for approval, Jody seconded, all in favor.

2. Principal Items:

LandTrust Grant applications:

Susan Hollberg: Scripts for classroom set of Antigone play. \$130.35

Treena Tuione: After school Math tutoring. \$1000.00

After extensive discussion as to the details of each grant request, John motioned for approval, Robert seconded the motion and all were in favor.

3. Council Member Items:

Paying for a 19 hour/week aide for the overburdened PE classes

The PE classes at Olympus Jr. have approximately 57-60 students per class. This is becoming a safety and management issue by our PE teachers.

After review of this request by Coach Robert Brough, Julie made a motion to amend our current LandTrust plan to allocate approximately the \$4000 needed to pay for an aide this coming second semester of school. John seconded the motion and all were in favor.

4. Olympus Network Reconfiguration:

Current district policy to continue the process for the instructional phase of reconfiguration

The GSD has communicated with Tina that every school in the Olympus Network must be in favor of starting the initial learning stage of reconfiguration for this process to begin. Our Community Council is concerned that a small minority of parents at any school in the Olympus Network will be able to dictate the rest of the networks desire to learn about the reconfiguration process. We do not feel that we can make an educated decision about how this would affect our school community, its families and students unless we are able to explore the investigation stage of reconfiguration. Our Community Council feels that our community is very much in favor of exploring reconfiguration and understanding it better.
