Election of Chair/Vice-Chair:

Additional Council Members:

A motion was made to add Katie Graham as an additional council member. This position will be a one-year term. Katie worked previously on the Council for several years. Her dedication and valuable insight was mentioned by several Council members. All Community Council Members present voted in favor.

Motion was made to increase add another employee to the CC: Mr. LeRoy expressed his belief that adding a school counselor (Corrine Kendall) to the CC would be helpful especially as we make plans for the switch to a 6-8th model for next year. All Community Council Members present voted in favor.

Principal's Report:

Last Year's School Land Trust Plan:

The teachers agreed that the money spent on teacher trainings over the summer was well spent. And the faculty trainings at the beginning of the year were well attended.

Current School Plan:

Joshua LeRoy talked about the academic goals of this year, specifically mentioning a goal to increase the RISE scores. The Plan is designed to be flexible.

Reconfiguration: Joshua LeRoy talked about the plans to move forward now that the District Board voted in favor of reconfiguration. 6th grade teachers from the network elementary schools were spoken to by the District about their options and they will be given first priority. More about the new 6-8th model will be discussed at next month's meeting.
