Land Trust Plan Topics (Josh LeRoy, Principal):

Josh is not convinced we will have the money for our 0.5 FTE SPED class. The district won't guarantee the money. We can only take on the students that we currently have the resources for.

We need to hire a computer teacher and a dance teacher...hoping it can be a part-time computer teacher. 6th graders will not have a foreign language option.

We have 105,500k for Land Trust this next year:

Teacher Summer Days (4 days @\$150/day)= 18k + benefits (30 teachers)

GT Collaboration Days (2 days @\$100/day)= \$1200 + benefits (6 teachers)

Aleks= \$14,500

Library= \$3,000

Tutoring= \$10,000

Total: \$54,600

Balance: \$50,900 (Josh suggests leaving it in case we need to fund a teacher. The Council agrees with him)

We're good on proficiency and okay on growth. Room for improvement. We are trying to create a school culture that cares about taking the RISE test.

Science fair coming back to the school. And we want more clubs...but that's hard because it requires a teacher off-contract to do it...
