1. Social/Emotional Curriculum

- a. This year Olympus Jr has the theme of Be Resilient and from there focus on a social and emotional component each month to build resilience.
 - i. September: Stronger Together
 - ii. October: Growth Mindset
 - iii. November: Self-Care
 - iv. December: Serving Others
 - v. January & February: Positive Thinking and Emotional Awareness
 - vi. March: Social Awareness
 - vii. April & May: Believe in Yourself and Keep Going
- b. Those lessons are presented the first Monday of the month in advisory.
- c. Counselors also create bulletin boards, newsletters, and videos to add on to what is taught in advisory.
- d. Every year counselors present a suicide prevention lesson to the whole school as required by the state.
 - i. Olympus Jr High has chosen to use the program Mindwise for materials and resources for the suicide prevention program.
 - ii. Parents and students will be notified of content that will be discussed before the lesson takes place.
 - iii. The lesson focuses on ACT; acknowledge signs of suicide in a friend, show your friend that you care, and tell a trusted adult.
 - iv. The lesson contains videos and discussion questions.
- e. Counselors hand out a safeUT card to students who they feel may need them and there are also posters around the school with safeUT information.
- f. When a student comes to a counselor presenting suicidal ideation the counselor notifies the parent, fills out a form to notify the principal, and sends home emotional and mental support resources for the parents.

2. Registration

- a. Registration for incoming 6^{th} graders will be due January 31^{st} .
 - i. Counselors will be in the elementary schools the week prior to give out information and registration cards.
- b. Registration for upcoming 7th graders will take place on Feb 2nd.
