- 2. Population study with Steve Hogan and Ben Horsley
 - a. Calendar year process not school year
 - Starts with a PAC meeting and suggestions are taken to the Granite School District Board on February 1st
 - c. February-May open houses and prep-surveys at a general location for multiple schools for recommendations
 - d. June-July take recommendations back to the Board
 - e. Continue collecting data throughout the rest of the year through surveys and open houses to get feedback. Talk with city officials and have community meetings.
 - f. There is a 180 day notice for possible boundary changes and school closers (happens in June)
 - g. September community council will look at some suggestions and make final recommendations and a final suggestion will be taken to the board in December.
 - h. Board makes a decision in October-December
 - i. Changes would happen Fall of 2023
 - i. Two studies
 - i. Van Winkle/7th East Corridor Study
 - 1. Low enrollment at Twin Peaks Elementary (225 students), like to see 3 teachers per grade level but seeing 2 per grade level
 - 2. Low enrollment at Spring Lane Elementary (280 students)
 - 3. <u>Purpose/Concern</u>: Looking at closure in schools
 - ii. Cottonwood Network Boundary Study
 - 1. Looking at Cottonwood Network (Cottonwood High School and all the feeder schools) and low enrollment
 - 2. Want around 550-700 students in Elementary Schools
 - 3. Want around 700-1000 students in Junior High, affects programs and schedule availability

- 4. Cottonwood is our smallest high school enrollment in the district
- 5. <u>Purpose/Concern</u>: After reconfiguration the concern is balancing 3 high schools (Skyline, Cottonwood, Olympus). Make 3 east-side robust high schools.
- 6. Possibly look at changing boundaries of high schools around Cottonwood to increase enrollment.
- 7. Low enrollment will continue to affect other networks in the area because of low birth rate
- 8. Open enrollment and charter/private schools' enrollment are other factors affecting enrollment
- k. Feedback from the community is so important!
- I. Need community council to get ideas and possible solutions on the table. More ideas the better.
