William Penn Elementary Summary of School LAND Trust Final Report 2018-2019

Providing opportunities for our students to realize their greatest potential is our main charge at William Penn Elementary. The focus of how our LAND Trust money is spent shows our dedication to getting results that show all students are growing and progressing. Our 2018-2019 LAND Trust funds were used to fund additional employees in our school. A .5 FTE was funded to ensure small class sizes and 3-5 paraprofessionals were funded to assist the Literacy Coach and classroom teachers meet the individual needs of students in small group instruction.

It is our school's goal to meet or exceed the Utah State Office of Education's Uniform Growth Goal set forth for our school. The Uniform Growth Goal for our school is 60% of students in grades K-6 will make typical or above typical growth according to the DIBELS End of Year Benchmark. According to the DIBELS End of Year Benchmark data, 77% of students in Grades K-6 made typical or above typical progress.

We appreciate and value the benefits of Utah's LAND Trust monies. Hiring personnel to assist teachers during small group instruction and ensure smaller class sizes in our school enables us to meet the needs of our diverse student population.
